- Other Topics Related to the Impact of Women on Supply Chains and the Logistics Industry

April 30, 2025	Submission of the full paper (see paper submission guidelines below). Papers will be published post-conference as part of the conference edition, provided at least one author presents the work in-person or online
May 14, 2025	Presentation of papers at the Scientific International Session (online or in person at Gdańsk University)**

Submission Guidelines

Abstract Guidelines

Authors must submit a 500-word abstract in Word format (.docx) for review by the Scientific Committee. The abstract should include:

- Purpose
- Research Approach
- Findings
- Originality and Research Impact
- Six Keywords

Abstracts must be limited to one A4 page and submitted via email to:

Full Paper Guidelines

Authors are required to follow these guidelines for full papers:

- Submit papers in Word format (.docx) to beata.trochymiak@kobietywlogistyce.pl
- Papers should not exceed eight A4 pages.
- The paper should begin with the title, followed by the authors' names and affiliations. Please include the following sections: abstract, introduction, a review of relevant literature, a description of the research, results/analysis, discussion, conclusions, and references.
- All section headings must be in Times New Roman 12pt bold and underlined, while subheadings should be in Times New Roman 11pt bold. A blank line should separate sections.

Figures and tables must be embedded within the text, with captions in Times New Roman 11pt centred below the respective element.

Margins must be set to 2.5 cm on all sides, with text fully justified. Paragraphs should not be indented, and a blank line should be used to separate them.

Language and Formatting

All papers and conference presentations must be in English.
