Current research focus

My current research focus is on decarbonization strategies in the freight transport and logistics. I am also conducting research on digitalization and sustainability in logistics and supply chain management and sustainability in urban logistics and last mile delivery.

Research activities conducted at the Italian National Research Council (1990 - 2024)

Since 1990, I have actively contributed to major research programs and projects at the institutes where I have been employed, frequently taking on leadership roles as head of research and project manager. Throughout this time, my scientific work has primarily centred on the following five key areas:

Area 1. Internationalisation and competitiveness of small and medium-sized enterprises

In this research area, I examined the internationalization processes of small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs), focusing specifically on Italian Leather-Shoes manufacturing SMEs in the Campania region. The specific topics investigated include:

- The international competitiveness of the Leather-Shoes supply chain
- Channel relationships and international competitiveness in the footwear industry
- Logistics management and competitiveness of SMEs in the footwear industry

This research was supported by the targeted national project of the Italian National Research Council, entitled: "Services for the Internationalization of Italian Companies and Exports Development."

Area 2. Analysis of organisational and technological changes in the maritime-port and logistics services sector

In this research stream, I carried out research on economics and management issues associated with transport and logistics with specific reference to the following topics:

- Analysis of the main drivers of change in the international shipping and port scenario
- Competitive strategies in the liner shipping industry
- Impact of alliances and partnerships on logistics service strategies of shipping lines

The research activities in this area have been funded by the targeted national project of the Italian National Research Council entitled: “*Transportation - 2nd edition*”.

Area 3. Impact of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) on logistics and supply chain

The focus of the scientific activities was on investigating the dissemination and impact of ICT innovations in logistics and supply chain. The research addressed the following three main topics:

- The impact of ICT on logistics, supply chain management and logistics services
- The diffusion of ICT in small Italian logistics services providers
- Training and new skills needs as a result of ICT dissemination in logistics companies.

The research in this area has been carried out in collaboration with the National Institute for Transport and Logistics (NITL), Dublin Institute of Technology, Dublin (Ireland).

Area 4. Knowledge management in the logistics service industry

Despite the increasing interest in studying knowledge management in logistics, this research was aimed to fill the gap in the current literature concerning the adoption of knowledge management in the logistics service industry. The research investigated how logistics service companies take advantage of knowledge management and what are the knowledge management practices supporting their strategies and improve performance. The main topics studied in this research are as follows:

- Knowledge management practices implemented by logistics service companies
- Barriers slowing down the adoption of such practices
- Knowledge management and performance of logistics service companies

Area 5. Freight Transport and logistics decarbonisation: The “Green Logistics Laboratory”

The growing importance of environmental sustainability in the transport and logistics service industry stems from its substantial contribution to global greenhouse gas emissions. This issue has been further exacerbated by the rising demand for goods mobility, which has surged over recent decades and is projected to continue growing. As a result, logistics service providers face mounting pressure to significantly reduce their environmental impact through effective actions and strategies. This challenge is particularly critical for Italy, one of Europe’s countries with the highest internal traffic density, where over 60% of goods transported beyond 50 km rely on road transport.

In this research area, the activities were organised into two phases. The first phase focused on assessing the extent to which logistics companies have adopted practices and initiatives to reduce their environmental impact. The findings revealed limited implementation of Green Logistics in Italy and a lack of systematic, ongoing studies. To address this gap the “Laboratory on Green Logistics” was established at ISMed-CNR during the second phase of the research project. The laboratory's mission is to raise awareness about the importance

of sustainability in logistics and promote the sustainable transition of logistics and freight transport through research and innovative solutions. The Laboratory's research activities are focused on three key areas:

- Decarbonization strategies of logistics and freight transport services
- Sustainable urban logistics
- Sustainability and digitalization in the supply chain
